



An one- day seminar was held on the 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2019, at the 5th Gymnasium of Ioannina, as part of the dissemination activities of the Erasmus project, entitled: "Integration of Museums into School Education".

The activity was attended by 18 teachers of Primary & Secondary Education, who teach History, Geography and Art in schools located in the city of Ioannina.

The aim of the training was the use of cultural and historical reference sites, as alternative non-formal learning environments for school audiences, through interactive participatory activities.

The teachers of the 5<sup>th</sup> Gymnasium who attended, during the first year of the project, two training activities in Slovenia and Piraeus on redefining the role and the educational dimension of museums, presented six pilot lesson plans for school trips at sites of cultural and historical interest in Ioannina.

Participating teachers from other schools had the opportunity to interact on the development of the lesson plans, to share their ideas and suggest ways and tools that could make educational visits to cultural sites more attractive to students.
